- ❖ **Tuesday, October 2, 2018: *Building Blocks of Student Leadership***
Topics to consider: essential leadership skills, practicing leadership, developing leadership “identity”, academic and co-curricular leadership programs, public speaking, delegation, teambuilding, student government, peer-to-peer leadership/mentoring
- ❖ **Tuesday, November 6, 2018: *Looking In: Fostering a Positive School Climate***
Topics to consider: restorative practices, discipline process, cyberbullying, handling behavior “unbecoming of a student” (i.e., where does school’s role end parents’ begin?), cultivating risk, fostering resiliency
