

ABOUT NIGHTINGALE

Founded in 1920, the Nightingale-Bamford School is an independent K–12 girls' school in New York City that provides a classical, liberal arts curriculum to students of varied backgrounds, interests, and talents. Through the arts and athletics, ample leadership opportunities, extracurricular activities, and community service, students are encouraged to go beyond barriers. Central to Nightingale's mission is a vision of students as joyful learners who have the intellectual depth and the courage to be critical thinkers, compassionate citizens, and agents of their own lives.

Middle School Counselor

The Nightingale-Bamford School seeks a full-time psychologist (4/5th time would be considered) or social worker with responsibilities primarily in the middle school. The middle school counselor will coordinate with the Director of Counseling to manage support primarily in the middle division, but also in the lower and upper divisions as needed. Experience with younger students a plus. Primary responsibility is for individual counseling and referral for students as appropriate and coordination for support with teachers, administrators, parents and outside professionals. The middle school counselor will also teach and participate in curriculum development for social emotional learning in the division and plan and produce parent education opportunities. The ideal candidate will be experienced and expert at providing psychological support in a diverse and inclusive community.

Masters or doctoral degree required as well as three years post-graduate school counselor or other clinical experience. Candidates must be New York State licensed or license-eligible.

Responsibilities including:

- Individual counseling and referral and outreach to families
- Coordinate with student support team to develop plans of support for students in need
- Collaborate with advisors, teachers, deans and other administrators
- Collaborate in design and delivery of SEL education and and prevention programs around mental health concerns
- Develop parent programming on relevant middle school issues
- Support and education for faculty on student psychological concerns
- Management of Peer Leadership program
- Participation in community activities
- Additional responsibilities as required
